

2024 Bourbon County 4H Shooting Sports welcomed 56 members this year across the five shooting disciplines of rifle, pistol, black powder, trap and archery. We gained five new coaches, Matt Jarvis, Myra Miller, Anthony Koch, Steve Fuller and Todd Sale and new coordinator, Bridgett Anderson. The shooting sports season holds weekly practices with competitions held locally through the summer, ending with the State Competition in September. This year at State we had 18 members compete in 41 events bringing home 9 trophies. After the State Competition we held an end of year Family Fun Shoot and Banquet in which the kids got to display their skills against their family members.

At the banquet we honored Coach Russell Marshall for his years of service to the program as he is passing on black powder coaching duties to future coach William Coleman.
